PUBLIC OUTREACH AND EDUCATIONAL EFFORTS

NNEPA PWSSP will function as the primary contact for individuals, organizations, and municipalities seeking information on the NNEPA Wellhead Protection Program. NNEPA staff are available to make presentations on the NNEPA wellhead protection program, participate in interjurisdictional or multi-purveyor wellhead protection implementation meetings and/or take other steps as appropriate to help implement local wellhead protection programs. A primary objective of NNEPA PWSSP is to educate water system owners/operators, interested citizens, Tribal staff and elected officials on the importance of wellhead protection on the Navajo Nation.

NNEPA PWSSP has primary responsibility for publicizing the NNEPA Wellhead Protection Program, although all of the Navajo Nation agencies should assume some responsibility for informing potentially affected communities and/or parties. NNEPA PWSSP will notify existing purveyors of the requirements of the program.

Wellhead Protection Workshops
